Kaplan Admission Test

LPN-RN Spring 2018 Class

The Associate Degree Nursing Program at Piedmont Community College uses the Kaplan Admission Test to aid in selecting candidates for the upcoming Nursing Class. The deadline to apply to the LPN-ADN program is September 1, 2017. Upon completion of Phase I (A-D Admissions Requirements), LPN's are eligible to take the Kaplan Admission Test.

PCC will administer the Kaplan Admission Test for LPN's only on the following dates in E-150 :

August 3 – 9:00am - 1:00pm

August 4 – 1:00pm - 5:00pm

How to apply and register for the Kaplan Admission Test:

Upon completion of Phase I (A-D Admission Requirements) and all materials received in the Admission's Office, LPN's are eligible to take the Kaplan Admission Test. **Students are only allowed to test once per academic year. Students who achieve an overall score of 65% will be given priority admission over those scoring lower than 65% due to these score correlating with a student successfully completing the nursing program.**

1. It is the student's responsibility to complete the application to test, see nursing advisor for signature, pay for the test and schedule a date to take the test prior to the last scheduled day of testing. **Applicants who qualify for testing accommodations, must request accommodation and notify the testing proctor prior to taking the test.**
2. **There is a \$25 fee for taking the test.** Seating for each exam is limited. Your seat will not be guaranteed until payment is received. After completing the registration form and paying for the test, applicants may come by the Information Desk in E Building to sign up for the Test. **If you miss the exam for any reason, your money is non-refundable.**

On the day of the exam, you must:

- Bring two forms of Identification. **One form must be a Photo ID.** This can be a driver's license, valid passport, or school picture ID. Students who fail to present two forms of identification as described above will not be admitted into the testing room.
- In order to take the test on this date, you must arrive at the testing location no later than 15 minutes before the appointed time. Absolutely no one will be admitted after testing has started.
- You will need to allow a minimum of 3 hours for taking the test, printing of the score reports, and checking out.

Study guides for the Kaplan Admission Test may be checked out from our library or purchased through the PCC Bookstore or other location.
