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## **Person-centered Care**

**Is the practice of basing  
resident care on individual  
resident needs, preferences and  
expectations**

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## Person-centered Care – Goals



- To see the person as a unique individual
  - To respect skills and abilities
- To support the person to be successful and maintain independence
- To help the person meet needs for attachment, inclusion, occupation and comfort
- To support the person as a member of a community

most are relationships

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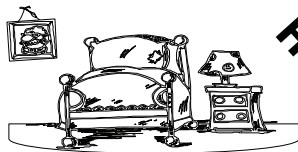
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## Person-centered Care – Importance
