Piedmont Community College (College) acknowledges the College signed and returned to the Department of Education (Department) the College's Certification and Agreement for Emergency Financial Aid Grants to Students under the CARES Act. This includes assurance that the College has used, or intends to use, no less than 50 percent of the funds received under Section 18004(a)(1) of the CARES Act to provide Emergency Financial Aid Grants to students.

- The College was funded \$1,111,495. from the Department pursuant to the College's Certification of Agreement and \$1,111,495 is designated for Student Aid.
- For HEERF III **report** ending **March 31, 2022**, the College distributed \$95,500 to students.
- The estimated total number of the College's students eligible to participate in the programs under Section 484 in Title IV of the Higher Education Act of 1965 and thus eligible to receive Emergency financial Aid Grants to students under Section 18004(a)(1) of the CARES Act report is 1080
- The total number of students who received an Emergency Financial Aid Grant under Section18004(a)(1) of the CARES Acts for the quarter ending March 31, 2022, report is 296.
