

Nursing Evening/Weekend Cohort Caswell County Campus

In January 2022, Piedmont Community College (PCC) started an Evening/Weekend Associates Degree Nursing program that is primarily located on the Caswell County campus in Yanceyville, NC. The inaugural cohort graduated in December 2023 with a 100% first-time pass rate on the NCLEX!!

Additional information about the Evening/Weekend cohort:

Evening/Weekend cohort

- o The first semester, students meet up to four evenings each week for lecture and labs.
- Subsequent semesters, students meet two to three evenings each week and then may have simulation/labs throughout certain courses.
- o Clinicals generally are on Fridays or Saturdays.
- Sundays-OFF (could change depending on clinical availability or meeting course objectives)

• Six semesters program

- Next session starts Spring 2025 (January 2025)
- o Anticipated graduation for this cohort is Fall 2026 (*December 2026*)
- Same Admissions policies and curriculum as the traditional PCC ADN/AGE programs
- Admissions Test: TEAS Test required for entry
