

# Nursing Evening/Weekend Cohort Caswell County Campus

In January 2022, Piedmont Community College (PCC) started an Evening/Weekend Associates Degree Nursing program that is primarily located on the Caswell County campus in Yanceyville, NC. The inaugural cohort graduated in December 2023 with a 100% first-time pass rate on the NCLEX!

# Evening/Weekend cohort

- o The first semester, students meet up to four evenings each week for lecture and labs.
- Subsequent semesters, students meet two to three evenings each week and then may have simulation/labs throughout certain courses.
- Clinicals generally are on Saturdays or Sundays. (days are dependent on clinical site availability or meeting course objectives)

## • Program is six (6) semesters long

- Sessions start every Spring semester (*January*)
- o Anticipated graduation for these cohorts is every Fall semester (*December*)
- Same Admissions policies and curriculum as the traditional PCC ADN/AGE programs
- Admissions Test: TEAS Test required for entry
  - See <u>Admissions Test Information</u> document for more information, including dates, times, and other requirements

# • Important Dates & Deadlines:

- o Admissions Tests are administered on Person and Caswell campuses
  - Offered July August annually
  - Numerous dates/times will be available
- o Deadline for application
  - September 1 annually
  - Nursing program applications are completed by candidates when they take the Admissions Test or when their official TEAS transcripts are received from ATI
- o Admission Decision/Letters to Students
  - On/by October 15 annually
- o Classes Begin
  - January annually
- Graduation
  - December annually
