FUNDING ASSISTANCE CONTACTS

If you live in our service area, contact one of the listed agencies to see if you qualify for financial assistance. Most approved students receive coverage for registration, textbooks, supplies, and exams. Approval typically takes up to 2 weeks, but can be faster if all documents are submitted promptly. Funding for future courses may also be available after successful completion.

To Secure Your Seat:

- Email the Program Director or Administrative Assistant by the payment deadline. Include your Case Worker's name and email address.
- This will count as your payment and hold your seat.
- **Do not pay** unless you're denied assistance.
- If we don't receive your info by the deadline, you'll be removed from the course.
- You—not your Case Worker—are responsible for sending this information.
- Goodwill *does not* cover the \$9 insurance fee. You are responsible for calling and making this payment before the course start date or you will be dropped.
