### Tuition and Refunds

**Tuition Costs:**

Tuition is \$76 per credit hour for In-State Tuition and \$268 per credit hour for Out-of-State Tuition. This rate is subject to change by the North Carolina Legislature. **Additional Fees:** Please see PCC [Tuition and Fees](#) for information.

**Changes To Schedule:**

If you need to drop and/or add a class on or after **May 20th**, you must do the drop/add at the same time to save money. If done at separate times, the system will reimburse you 75% of the tuition for the dropped class and charge you 100% for the added class. The Business Office will not be able to reimburse you the remaining 25%.

**Drop-Add-Withdraw:** Drop and Add dates may vary by class to ensure deadlines are not missed, we encourage all students to review course information provided by the instructor. If a student is withdrawn from a course, **NO** refund will be given. Students receiving financial aid and or scholarships are encouraged to speak with a representative prior to withdrawing as there may be financial consequences.
