

Campus Safety Tips

- ▶ Always be alert and aware of the people around you. **Report** any unusual and suspicious behavior to College personnel. Help prevent crime and protect yourself and others!
- ▶ Do not allow people to follow you into secure locations without proof of authorization to be there.
- ▶ **Trust your instincts!** If you feel uncomfortable in a place or situation, leave and immediately go to an area with lights and people.
- ▶ Use well-lit , high-traffic routes when walking on campus, and do not walk alone at night. **Upon request**, a Campus Safety Official can provide an escort.
- ▶ Stay aware of your surroundings. Listening to music or using your phone can distract you from people or vehicles around you.
- ▶ Do not display valuables openly. Leave them at home or locked inside the trunk of your vehicle.
- ▶ Be sure to lock your vehicle. Keep a spare key somewhere in case you lock your keys in the vehicle. Campus Safety Officials are **not** allowed to unlock your vehicle. You will need to call a locksmith.
- ▶ **Always evacuate for fire alarms.** Do not use the elevators. Remain at least 150 feet from the building in a designated area (Green Zone). Do NOT re-enter the building for any reason until instructed to do so by emergency responders or College Safety Officials.
